- Identify useful intervention techniques for children with ASD

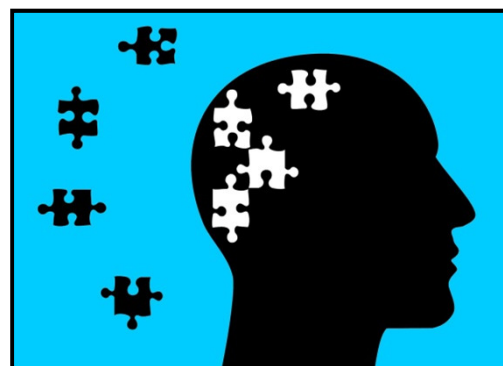
