

Yes/No Questions Graphic Symbols

Yes-No questions can occur with question forms including:

- *Is this a _____?*
- *Do you want a _____?*

A person responding to a Yes-No question needs to:

- (1) Understand the question requires a *Yes* or a *No* response and
- (2) Have a means of expressing that understanding

Yes and *No* can be expressed through speech, through a gesture (typically a head nod or shake or ASL sign) or graphic form (please see below).

When introducing Yes-No questions, it is suggested that familiar objects be used at first while repeatedly using the same Yes-No question forms. The learner is expected to respond using the selected means of representing the yes-no response (e.g., graphic or gestural).
