


## Preparing for a Job

### Helpful Tips & Vocabulary for Use at Home

Your son/daughter will be working at a grocery store. At the grocery store students restock shelves, collect and return carts to the store and participate in general cleaning tasks.



- Have your child help you unload groceries and place them in the correct cabinets and the refrigerator at home.
- When shopping at the grocery store, direct your child's attention to the different areas located in the store. Examples: produce, frozen foods, dairy. Point out signs and aisle numbers.
- Have your son/daughter return the cart to the cart area in the parking lot. Help them look for traffic and wait patiently as it passes before they continue to pushing the cart.
